

ISPORTS TRAINING SEMINARS

7 Training Seminars will be organised in partner countries in December 2021. The partners will present to stakeholders' representatives the ISports curriculum. The objective of the seminars will be:

- a) to train sport club managers, coaches, sport professionals and athletes on how to prevent, report and respond to sexual harassment incidents with sport clubs and
- b) to collect feedback from the aforementioned representatives, in terms of the structure, contents and methodologies, in order to ensure that the project outputs will achieve the objective originally set.

The events will also be serving the purpose of raising awareness on the project, engaging these categories of stakeholders and ensuring increased impact and sustainability prospects.



ISPORTS MULTIPLIER EVENTS

8 Multiplier Events are going to be organised in partner countries. The multiplier events aim at engaging members of the target group, in order to raise awareness about the project and its expected results, but, most importantly, inform them about the ISports MOOC. In particular, the partners will invite to the event sport club managers, coaches, sport professionals, athletes, policy makers and other stakeholders to present the developed Outputs (O1-O4) and ensure that they will then participate at the ISports MOOC and provide their feedback.

The events will also include parallel sports activities open to the public, as a means to promote the inclusiveness in sports, but also to inspire people in engaging in any sport activity in their everyday life, being an important factor of good health, quality of life and psychological support.

The events will be also available through online streaming via the project's website and social media.

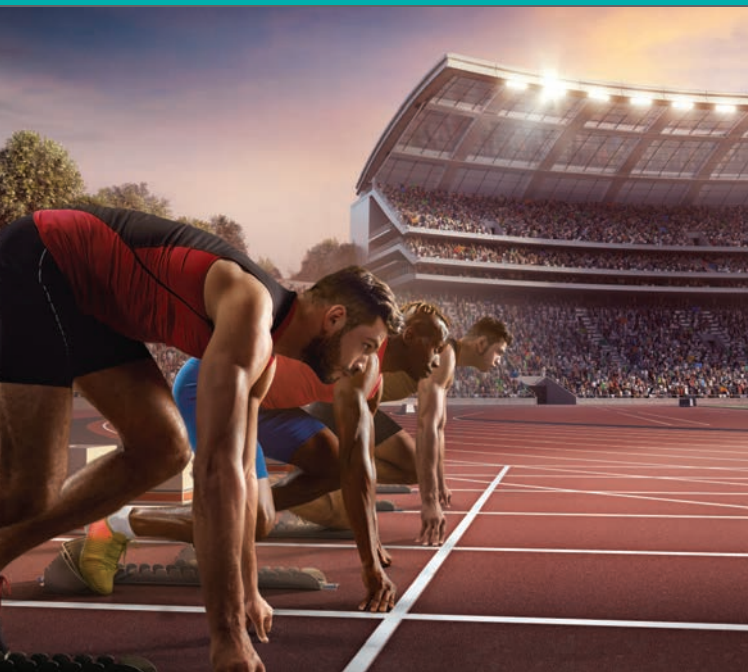
INTEGRATED APPROACH

The ISports project main objective is to develop a holistic approach for the protection of young athletes from any form of sexual harassment, empowering sport professionals, young athletes and sport clubs towards sexual harassment detection, prevention, and combat.



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MAJOR ISPORTS RESULTS

Tailored training programme

The training Programme: 'Sexual harassment prevention training in Sport' will address sport club managers, coaches, sport professionals and athletes.
